GLOBAL YOUTH CHALLENGE 2025 - AN AMAZING EVENT!





May 29, 2025

The latest date all applicants who submitted their application by the January application deadline can expect a response from an Ontario university. This includes an offer of admission, a refusal or a deferral, once additional information is received.



June 2, 2025

The earliest date an applicant may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit).

All other admission-related elements, including scholarships, other forms of student assistance or financial incentives, and offers of residence, are considered part of the offer of admission. Therefore, a student may accept these other offers before June 2, 2025, but Ontario universities will not compel a student in any way to make a decision before this date.



THE GLOBAL YOUTH CHALLENGE - GYC 2025






